To Whom it May Concern,

Aloha. My name is Loren Cunningham, I am the Founder of the University of the Nations (U of N). The U of N Kona campus is one of the largest campuses in the world. It is part of the network of campuses worldwide that train and send out missionaries with YWAM whose mission is "to know God and make Him known". This particular campus was established to "be a lighthouse to the Pacific and a stepping stone to Asia".

Each year, we have about 15 Discipleship Training Schools (DTS) that run alongside 30 upper level courses and countless seminars. The number of students attending these courses continues to grow. Averaging 200-300 student every quarter.

I experienced the benefits of USES® when I had one installed in my personal residence. It showed immediate savings of 15% reduction on my utility bill. When I recognized the savings I encouraged my board to purchase a unit for the kitchen facility which feeds the entire campus 3 meals a day and is an area that draws a large amount of energy. We installed a XL-3 208D and this is the savings we have had since installation.

USES® was installed in our kitchen facility on April 7, 2014, the billing details are included.

The total four month savings after removing the HELCO rate increase is \$11,572, for a four month utility cost reduction average of 6.6%. USES® reduced the kWh by 32,111.

We are happy with our savings that have exceeded the proposed expectations and plan to install additional units in our new facilities just completed on our Kona campus.
